¹ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through Him, and without Him was not any thing made that was made. ⁴ In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. ⁵ The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

The Word of God

1. It is an integrated messaging system (John 5³⁹)
2. Its origin is outside time [**PROPHECIES**] (Isa. 46⁹⁻¹⁰)
3. There are hidden treasures & answers (Prov. 25²)
4. It is our FAITH RESTORER (Rom.10¹⁷)

Prophecies About Jesus

1. He would be born of a virgin (**Gen 3¹⁵ spoken 4000 BC**, Isa. 7¹⁴ **700+ BC** / fulfilled in Matt. 1¹⁸)
2. He would be born in Bethlehem (Micah 5² / fulfilled in Matthew 2¹⁻²)
3. He would sojourn in Egypt (Hos. 11¹ / fulfilled in Matthew 2¹⁹⁻²¹)
4. He would live in Galilee (Isa. 9¹⁻²)
5. He'd be announced by an Elijah-like herald (Isa. 40³⁻⁵, Mal. 3¹, Mal. 4⁵) / fulfilled in John 1²⁹
6. He would occasion massacre of Bethlehem's children (Gen 35¹⁹⁻²⁰, Jer. 31¹⁵)
7. He was to be of David's family (2 Sam 7¹²⁻¹⁶, Ps. 89³⁻⁴, Ps. 110¹, Ps. 132¹¹, Isa. 9⁶⁻⁷, Isa. 11¹)
8. He would proclaim a Jubilee to the world (Isa. 58⁶, Isa. 61¹)
9. His mission would include the Gentiles (Isa 42¹⁻⁴)
10. His ministry would be one of healing (Isa. 53⁴⁻⁵)
11. He would teach through parables (Isa. 6⁹⁻¹⁰, Ps. 78²)
12. He would be disbelieved, rejected by Rulers (Ps. 118²², Isa. 53)

Prophecies About His Last Week

1. Would make a triumphant entry into Jerusalem (Zech. 9⁹, Ps. 118²⁵⁻
2. Betrayed by friend for 30 pieces of silver (Zech. 11¹⁻¹³)
3. Would be like a smitten shepherd (Zech. 13⁷)
4. Would be given vinegar and gall (Ps. 69¹⁻³)
5. They would cast lots for His garments (Ps. 22¹⁸)
6. His hands and feet would be pierced (Zech. 12¹⁰, Ps. 22¹⁶)
7. Not a bone would be broken (Num 9¹², Ps. 34²⁰)
8. Would die among the wicked (Isa. 53^{9,12})
9. His dying words would be "Father, forgive them" (Ps. 22¹, 31⁵)
10. Would be buried by the rich (Isa. 53⁹)
11. Rise from the dead on the 3rd day (Ps. 16¹⁰⁻¹¹, Jon. 1⁷, Hos. 6²)
12. Resurrection followed by destruction of Jerusalem (Dan. 9²⁶, 11³¹, 12^{1,11})

⁸ But to the Son He [*the Father*] says, “Your throne, **O God**, endures forever and ever. You rule with a sceptre of justice. ⁹ You love justice and hate evil. Therefore, **O God**, Your God has **anointed** You, pouring out the oil of joy on You more than on anyone else.” ¹⁰ He also says to the Son, “In the beginning, **Lord, You** laid the foundation of the earth and made the heavens with Your hands. ¹¹ They will perish, but you remain forever. They will wear out like old clothing.

Fully God – His Divinity

God's nature demonstrated in Jesus

- His Omnipotence
 - Healing Power (Matt. 8¹⁶ “*demon-possessed*”, Matt. 15³⁰ “*lame, blind, etc*”)
 - Calming the storm (Matt. 8²⁵⁻²⁷)
 - Water to wine (Jn.2¹⁻¹¹) / Multiplied loaves and fish (Matt. 14¹³⁻²¹)
- His Omniscience
 - Knowing people's thoughts (Mk. 2⁸, John 16³⁰)
 - Knowing hidden treasures (Matt. 17²⁷)
 - Know private moments (John.1⁴⁸)
- His Omnipresence
 - Matt 18²⁰

- His soul was troubled (John 12²⁷, 13²¹, Heb. 5⁷)

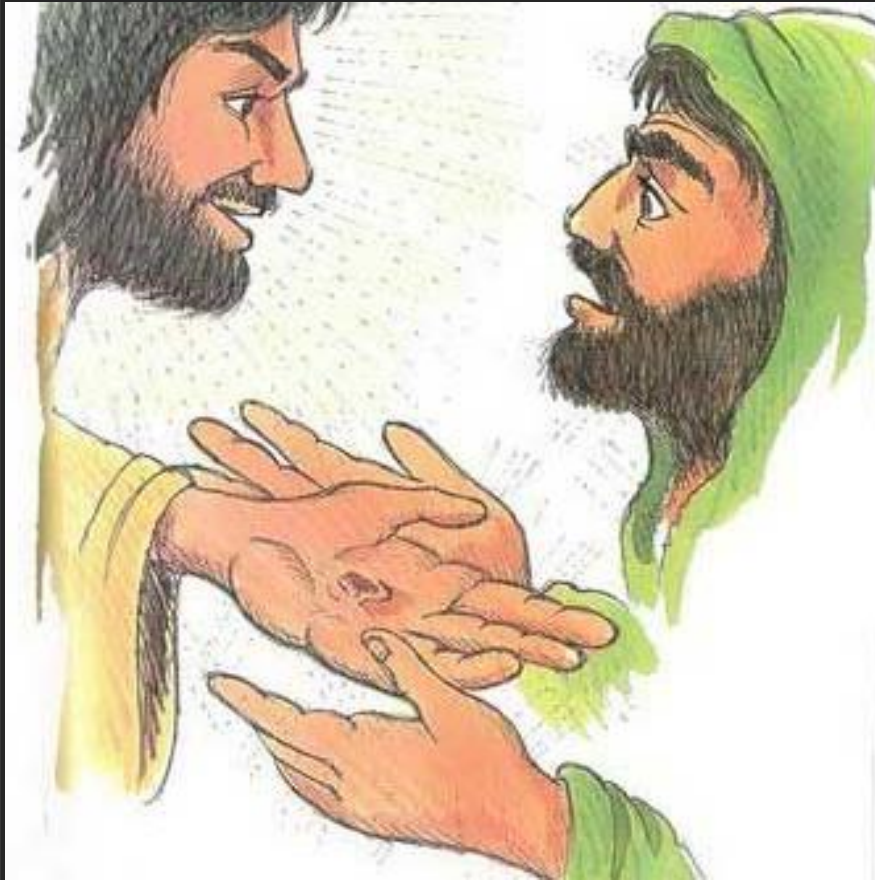
Fully Man

His humanity was necessary

- The perfect example of obedience (Phi. 2⁶⁻⁸, Rom. 5¹⁸⁻¹⁹)
- The only acceptable substitute sacrifice (Heb. 2¹⁶⁻¹⁷)
- The only Mediator between God and man (1 Tim. 2⁵)
- He is our empathising High Priest (Heb. 2¹⁸, 4¹⁴⁻¹⁶)
- To fulfil God's original purpose for Man to rule over creation (Matt. 21¹⁻¹⁷, Luke 1³²⁻³³, Heb. 2⁸)

What's In It For Me?

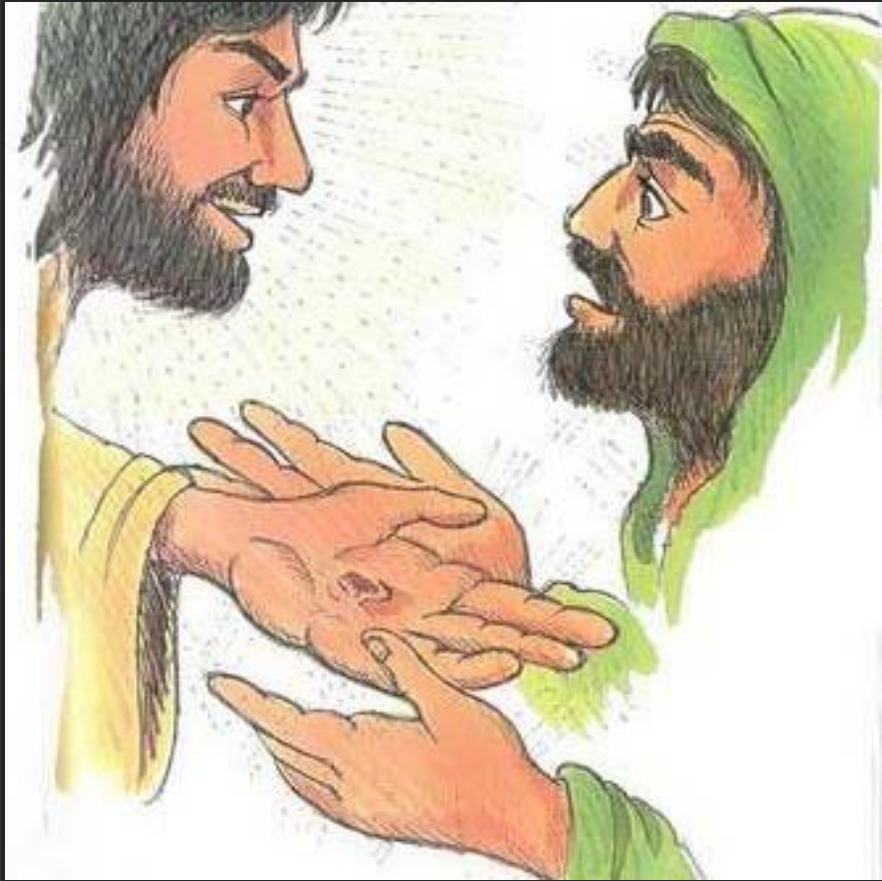
1. A deep & meaningful relationship with God (Rom. 5^{1, 11})
